The Surrey All Age Mental Health Investment Fund (MHIF) has granted funding to 13 projects that provide innovative, community-focused programmes.

Barnardo's are delighted to share that Surrey Paediatrics Parenting Service is one of these 13 projects. Our service officially opened in May 2024.

The Paediatrics Parenting Support Service is offering support to parent/carers and their families living in Surrey who are exploring the possibilities that their young person, 5 years old and younger may be neurodivergent. Empowering parents/carers with the support and tools they need to allow their young people to thrive.

What we offer

Our service encourages parents/carers to explore the early developmental stages of young people, offer a deeper understanding into emotional regulation, explore strategies that can be used at home and shared with childcare provisions.

Our practitioners provide a 6-week group intervention, either online or face-to-face in the community.
