What is a Key Worker?

A key worker is there to help you, they are there to advocate for you and your young person. At a time of high anxiety, it can be hard. They are there to ensure all services are doing what they should be doing, with no delays. Sometimes your young person may not want to engage but you can still get the support from a key worker.



Support from your Key Worker

A key worker will provide dedicated support to

empower your young person to reach their potential. The service will enable them to have support when it's needed. Your key worker, with your young person, will co-produce a person-centred, need-based support plan, ensuring continuity of the right services and support to meet their needs once key working involvement ends.
